## A VOLUNTARY ACTION SCHEME ON RAISING AWARENESS AND EXCHANGING GOOD PRACTICES TO DEAL WITH RISKS ARISING FROM OCCUPATIONAL EXPOSURE TO CARCINOGENS

Whereas exposure to carcinogens at the workplace can lead to very serious health damage;

Whereas the signatories underline the need to prevent or reduce exposure to carcinogens at the workplace;

Whereas governments, European commission, social partners, businesses, economic sectors, research institutes and other organisations have knowledge of awareness raising activities and good practices that prevent or reduce exposure to carcinogens at the workplace;

The signatories of this Covenant stress the importance of promoting awareness raising as well as the development and exchange of good practices that prevent or reduce exposure to carcinogens at the workplace;

The signatories commit themselves to promoting awareness raising as well as the exchange of best practices, by, inter alia, calling upon stakeholders in their networks to participate actively in the exchange of good practices.

This Covenant remains valid until 31 December 2019. Signed at 25 May 2016, Amsterdam, the Netherlands.
